Introduction:

Reason for choosing double masters:

I have experienced that my current master's degree limits the earning, as after completing my master's I pursued my professional career and during these years of hard work, I realized that each time I had applied for growth in the organization and was told that I don't have formal qualification related management, and this made me realize that no matter how long I keep on working as a I never had chance to become anything beyond that position. During the time, I have realized that having technical knowledge is never enough. To move forward in my career, I wish to combine my technical skills with expertise in the accounting aspect. Thus, I aim to enroll in a hands-on, functional higher education course such as Master of Project Management at CQUniversity Australia. Thus, owning double specialization, i.e., my previous post-graduate degree plus this one, I see myself having a bright career with lucrative job prospects ahead.

Reason for not choosing Nepal for my further studies:

The first and foremost reason for not choosing Nepal is that in the present scenario, Master of Project Management hasn't been offered by any universities of Nepal till the date. Project management topics are available only as part of the course. We do not have a specific degree of project management offered in Nepal. So, I chose to study overseas. I did research on the courses in Nepalese universities and colleges. Some of the universities for MBM program are listed below: Pokhra University https://pu.edu.np/, Purbanchal University https://purbanchaluniversity.edu.np/, Kathmandu University School of Management https://tribhuvan-university.edu.np/faculty/1_5dbbd9852140f etc.

The above-mentioned courses are provided by the universities and colleges of Nepal but are not capable of providing a well-recognized degree to the students and therefore creates difficulties for students to compete in international job markets. There are few drawbacks of higher education in Nepal like:

- The politicization of educational institutions is the primary explanation for or the root cause of Nepal's disgraceful state of education. The struggle between the Student's Unions that represent key political bodies has had a damaging effect on education in Nepal.
- Nepalese universities have relatively low rankings, and the relevance of Nepalese qualification is essentially limited to the South Asian region. As a result, the certification from Nepalese Universities is not globally acclaimed.
- The core curriculum is outmoded in comparison to current industry relevance; the curriculum is heavily weighted toward teaching conceptual knowledge rather than practical skills that can be immediately applied in the industry.
- The educators are insufficiently qualified to provide adequate understanding on the subject.
- Additionally, these institutes' technological infrastructure is basic, with outdated computer labs and analogue equipment that most certainly does not satisfy current industry requirements.

I am looking for an international exposure in both theoretical and practical way of teaching and learning which I found at CQUniversity.

Reasons for not choosing other countries like USA/UK/Canada for my further studies:

While considering study destinations abroad, I came across countries specifically USA, UK, Canada, and Australia. During my research I found that-

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA:

Universities which I have researched in USA are Northwestern University, Auburn University, New York University, Pennsylvania State University and so on. https://www.mastersportal.com/study-options/269778969/project-management-united-states.html

These above-mentioned University's tuition fees and living expenses are very high. Comparing the Exchange rate of USA and Australia, USD is higher than AUD. (USD 1 = NPR 119.88/-, whereas AUD 1 = NPR 84.53/-). The USA has always been the first choice to acquire an international degree for international students. USA has top, world-ranked universities. Most of the universities do require GRE and an English proficiency examination. In USA's top-most universities, students need to apply almost one year before to the desirable year of intake, that too with complete academics, IELTS or TOEFL, GRE etc. Also, they do not guarantee the quality education for international students whereas Australia guarantees for the quality education for international students through the ESOS Act. Recently it has been noticed that a few American universities have been blacklisted and students have been deported from the country even after having a valid visa. I have come across the fact that few of the students have landed up in American universities – which look more like warehouses than universities. This may be the case with very few universities but as an international student, it is my top priority to step into a country & university where I do not have to face such undesirable incidents. Moreover, USA has a high crime rate and Australia has a low crime rate.

UNITED KINGDOM:

Universities which I have researched in UK are University of Manchester, University of Essex, Queen's University Belfast and so on. https://www.masterstudies.com/MSc/Project-Management/United-Kingdom/

The important reason was the money part. While the education cost in Australia came out much economical for me, it was in UK that I found it to be very expensive and this is largely due to the forex exchange rate of GBP again Nepali rupee. Our Rupee is valued very low again the GBP. **GBP 1 = NPR 161.17/-** whereas **AUD 1 = NPR 84.53/-.** Another reason is due to extreme cold climate in England which can lead up to freezing temperature which is not suitable for me. Also, the blacklisting of universities is a major concern for an international student. I also looked for scholarships in universities and found limited Scholarship being offered. For me education is very important and I value money very much. When I know that I can get affordable and economically better options then I opted for one in Australia.

CANADA:

I have searched few universities like Centennial College Toronto, Northeastern University, Seneca College, Cambrian College etc. https://skoolville.com/blog/masters-in-project-management-in-canada/

Tuition fee is extremely high for international students. It's difficult for a middle-class family to send their son/daughter to Canada for studies, if they do not have a good scholarship, as currency conversion rate is high as compared to Australia. (CAD 1 = NPR 94.09/- whereas AUD 1 = NPR 84.53/-). The other factor which I know, I cannot surpass is the extreme and harsh winter conditions. I don't like winters and Canada is a country which gets heavy snowfall in winters. I really do not want to gamble with my parents hard earned life savings. I know I can't bear winters and I really don't have time and money to experiment with my career. Also, Canada is the 2nd largest country in the world, so getting around can be quite hard sometimes. Hence, I opted for the best destination for me which is Australia.

Based on further research, I found Australia to be the very right option for my higher education.

Reason for choosing Australia for my study destination:

After a thorough research on overseas countries, I came to a decision that Australia is a country that will fulfill all my needs related to my education and future career plan.

- 1. Australian education system is very logical and emphasis on practicality so that students can develop their intellectual. Courses that are being offered by Australian Universities are of wide variety.
- 2. The language that is being used in Australian education system is English and I have good understanding of this language. I will not face any difficulty while understanding my Lecturers and Professors.
- **3.** The climatic condition of Australia is very much similar to Nepal so I will not face any difficulties while I will be in Australia.
- **4.** Teaching methodology of Australia is of high quality as a variety of teaching methods are used like:

Teacher-directed learning Group projects Student research and presentations etc.

- **5.** Scholarships are provided to the students which can help them to achieve their goal in the life. Each year Australian Government provides approx. \$200 million dollars in scholarships for international students.
- **6.** Post study work visa of 3 years is also a great advantage for the international students as they can get work experience of their field at international level and can use it wherever they start their job in the future.
- 7. To maintain the quality of education in Australia, Australian Qualification Framework has been established in 1995, since that year, this body ensures the standard of teaching system that serves to the need of students. If a student is studying in College and University that is affiliated to AQF (Australian Qualification Framework) this means that institute is genuine. Education system of Australia is accredited and trustworthy.
- **8.** ESOS-Act (Education Services for Overseas Students) as well as TPS (Tuition Protection Services) code governed by the Australian Department of Education & Training, so there is no second doubt raised on the authenticity of the education provider. The Tuition Protection Service (TPS) which ensures the safety of student's tuition fees. The degrees, qualifications that are awarded to students are accredited, acclaimed, and valued across the globe, this is the reason why in the current market, Australia has consistently gained an edge over other countries. Due to these above said reasons I am choosing Australia for my higher education.

About my chosen city – Sydney:

At CQUniversity I am getting 25% International Student Scholarship. Therefor my total tuition fees become AUD 47,250/- from AUD 63,360/- which is a big saving for me and my family.

After completing this course, graduates will be able to design and implement initiatives, as well as identify and address our weaknesses and problems. This course prepares students to be proactive in business circumstances and to build the leadership abilities needed to manage and coordinate teams in day-to-day business activities. Project management graduates will also gain knowledge and competence in project and portfolio management in today's world. Furthermore, academics have the opportunity to participate in research that allows them to learn the most up-to-date concepts and strategies for leading complicated projects. As a result, I believe that this course is the best fit for my requirements and goals.

Course Structure: The course consists of 2 years of duration in which there are total 16 units with 96 credit points which include 11 core units and 4 electives.
